

An addition to your bucket list – Arunachal Pradesh – A destination worth a visit!

Let's visit a place which borders of the states of Assam and Nagaland and shares international borders with Bhutan in the west, Myanmar in the east and is separated from China in the north by the McMahon Line - Arunachal Pradesh.

But is adorned with beautiful picturesque landscapes still unexplored and has a culture backed up from 1987. Adorned with unspoilt landscapes. The tourist places in Andhra Pradesh call out for traveller's attention. It is a place that every nature lover and explorer must visit. Variety of things to do in Andhra Pradesh , include, but is not limited to trekking , angling, rafting, visiting and observing the wildlife, with the presence of tribes and subtribes , watch out for cultural and heritage-rich tours of the city, photography, motor-biking, root bridges, camping, birdwatching, tribal tours, music and dance of each tribe is something unique of the place.

Arunachal Pradesh distinctively has 12 tourist circuits or we may mention tourist places to visit in Andhra Pradesh with distinct features, character, ethnic culture, topography and vegetation.

Tourist places in Andhra Pradesh also include Tawang Monastery, which is 400 years old and is the largest monastery in India, it is a landmark of the state. Additionally one can also visit Tawang War Memorial Jaswant Garh, Tawang Craft Center, Nuranang Falls, Urgelling Gompa, Brahma-dung-Chung Ani Gompa, Pangateng Tso, and Bap Teng Kang Waterfall. Interested in photography and some spare time away from regular life with wildlife? Namdapha National Park, Itanagar Wildlife Sanctuary, Talley Wildlife Sanctuary, Pakhui Wildlife Sanctuary and Pakhui Wildlife Sanctuary are amongst the best places for visiting for a wildlife tour in Arunachal as they are homes to some rare species.

Parasuram Kund in Lohit district is amongst the most popular places to visit in Arunachal, which is not only famous amongst Hindu pilgrims but tourists amongst as well. The tallest lingam unearthed, The 25 ft Shiva Lingam in Kardo Hills is another major attraction for devotees. The Ita Fort, which is situated in the state's capital, Itanagar reveals the state's history and rich ethnic culture. Yet another place of interest could be The Sela Pass, at an elevation of 4170 m and situated between the Tawang and West Kameng Districts. The Sela lake is another famous destination to visit. Arunachal Pradesh is home to about 101 lakes.

The tourist places in Andhra Pradesh have activities which attract tourists. Things to do in Andhra Pradesh can be more elaborated upon. This place suits every personality, if you are an introvert, explore the vineyards, the cultural heritage, watch dance and enjoy the music, savour their cuisine. Arunachal Pradesh enjoys proudly the existence of big four of the animal kingdom namely, Tiger, leopard, clouded leopard and snow leopard. The state enjoys 26 major tribes including subtribes. If you are an adventurer, get your blood gushing with treks. For trekkers, the Bomdila-Tawang offers enormous scope. Tawang Chu attracts most of the trekkers because of its challenges. Starting from Jong, one can trek to Mago. May and October are the best months. You may choose to reach the place by train, through registered tour operators, by road, by sea, or by flight. You may browse through the internet for registered tour operators and rates of flights which will help you at ease! There is an excellent infrastructure of roads, rail facilities, airports and ports, which makes Andhra Pradesh easily accessible from every part of India and international cities. So go ahead! Pack your bags especially in the months of November to February. Andhra Pradesh is least recommended during summer as the temperature can hit a maximum of 45°C, making it an incredibly inconvenient option to travel to the state. Heavy rainfall and high humidity levels are experienced during the monsoons which may not be what most tourists are looking for. So the best time to explore the state of Andhra Pradesh is during the winter season, i.e. between November and February when the weather is pleasant and comfortable for the tourists to visit all the tourist attractions.
